The third commercial product based on CTM's FoxTrot search engine (after [CTM PowerMail](http://foxtrot.ch) 5.6.4 and CTM FoxTrot Personal 2.0), [FoxTrot Professional Search](http://foxtrot.ch) offers precision tools for finding the proverbial "needle in a haystack" within PDF, HTML, word processing, e-mail and multimedia metadata, including:

- various categorizations of search results, relevance-ranked
- document preview and full view, with secondary document-level search
- multiple indexed collections and timed updates without the application launched
- client-side access to FoxTrot Professional servers¹
- worldwide Unicode text support

FoxTrot Professional is relevant to anyone with personal or downloaded documents saved for future work; in field testing, the product has been especially well received in legal (law firm and courts), media (newsrooms researchers, ad agencies and editors) and mobile contexts (MacBook users carrying reference documents). A 30-day evaluation version is available now as public beta from foxtrot.ch/download

PRICING

FoxTrot Professional Search is priced at 99 Euro for a single-user version, 199 Euro for a 5-user version with client-side networking. Licenses are immediately delivered within the application itself via a secure transaction to the [Kagi store](http://foxtrot.ch).

UPGRADES

FoxTrot Personal Search 1.5 owners have been offered a special FoxTrot Professional Search for 50 Euro until June 30th, 2008 (70 Euro thereafter).
